Thousands of Indiana college students should benefit from new or expanded internship and placement opportunities to be offered through the myriad of collaborative programs that will receive funding in Lilly Endowment’s Initiative to Promote Opportunity Through Educational Collaborations.

Cobb, Endowment vice president for education. “Dozens of new relationships with alumni and others have been developed that will offer numerous internships and other experiential education opportunities for Indiana students.”
